Next week you're going to be asked to take an important decision on behalf of our friends and neighbours in Croydon. As the local MP I would like to know where you stand on the biggest issue facing our country today.

In June 2016 people up and down the UK gave a clear instruction to the Government and to Parliamentarians that we should leave the European Union. I respect that result and believe we should leave the EU.

That's why I think all talk of a second EU referendum is deeply concerning. Not only would it re-open divisions within our communities, but it would destroy the fragile faith left in our democratic systems.

My position is clear, yours should be too.
